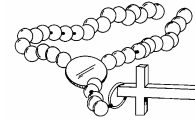

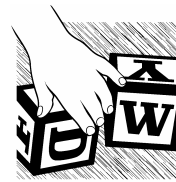
Thursday Rosary and Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament 10:00 AM

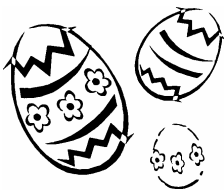
