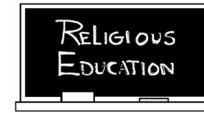

THE STORY OF DIVINE MERCY



In Poland in the 1930's, a nun named Sister Mary Faustina Kowalska began seeing an image of Jesus. She saw Him standing with His right hand raised and His left hand on His heart, from which two bright rays of light (red and pale) were shining outward.

Jesus began speaking to Sister Faustina.

He told her to paint the vision that she sees, write "Jesus I trust in You" at the bottom of the painting, and show it to the world with the message that He would grant Divine Mercy and total forgiveness to those who would trust in Him and confess their deepest sins, and then accept His body in holy communion on the Sunday after Easter.

Sister Faustina began carrying out Jesus' wishes. She also kept a diary of her mystical experiences with Him and the extraordinary things He told her about His infinite mercy. She died of tuberculosis at the age of 33, the same age that Jesus died.

Sister Faustina's diary was later approved by the Catholic Church and on Sunday, April 30, 2000, Pope John Paul II, a major advocate of Divine Mercy and the testimony of Sister Faustina, canonized her "Saint Faustina" (the first saint of the new millennium) and declared globally that the Sunday after Easter shall be named "Divine Mercy Sunday", in accordance with the Lord's wishes in His revelations to her.

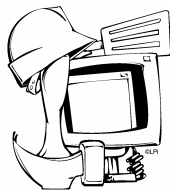
