Saying the Rosary for the Divine Mercy say

"Eternal Father, I offer you the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of your dearly beloved Son, Our Lord Jesus Christ, in atonement for our sins and those of the world."

On the Hail Mary Beads say

"For the sake of his sorrowful Passion have mercy on us and on the whole world"

In conclusion say three times

"Holy God, Holy Mighty One, Holy Immortal One, have Mercy on us on the whole world"

"O Blood and Water, which gushed forth from the Heart of Jesus as a fount of mercy for us, I trust in You."

Distribution of the Most Precious Blood

Starting Sunday, April 19th, 2009 St. Peter's Parish will begin to offer the Eucharist under both species during each Mass. The host will be offered as well as the distribution of the Most Precious Blood. Please refer to the following guidelines:

- The communicant will bow before receiving the Most Precious Blood
- The minister will hold the Chalice before each communicate and say "*The Blood of Christ*"
- The communicant responds with an "*Amen*" and the minister hands the cup to the communicant, who receives the cup, takes a sip and hands the cup back to the minister of the cup.
- The dipping of Hosts into the Most Precious Blood is not allowed. Consume the host prior to receiving the cup.
- If you have a cold or Flu please consider refraining from receiving the Most Precious Blood until you are feeling better.
