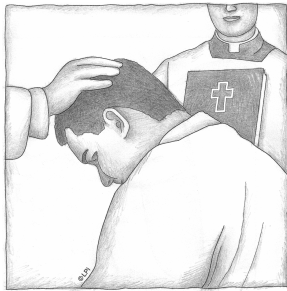


Our usher Bill Burke is doing better from the accident in front of our church but has a long road of recuperation from his injuries. He is currently at Mass General, please keep him in your prayers.
