Anyone who would like to register their children for religious education classes in the fall should contact Karen LeBlanc or Carol Holland at 508-746-8268.

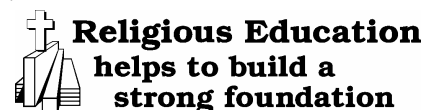
If your child is entering grade 1 in the fall, you must register them for religious education classes if they intend to make their First Penance and First Communion in grade 2. The deadline for early registration is June 30, 2009 in order to take advantage of a reduced fee for tuition.

Religious education teachers and volunteers are needed for the fall classes. The following grades are in need of teachers:

- Grade 1 – 5 classes need teachers (3 Monday, 2 Wednesday)
- Grade 2 – 4 classes need teachers (4 on Sunday)
- Grade 3 – 3 classes need teachers (1 Monday, 2 Wednesday)
- Grade 4 – 1 class needs a teacher (Tuesday)
- Grade 5 – 2 classes need teachers (1 Monday, 1 Wednesday)
- Grade 6 – 1 class needs a teacher (Tuesday) Grade 7 – 1 class needs a teacher (Tuesday)
- Grade 8 – 2 classes need a teacher (Tuesday)
- Grade 9 – 2 classes need a teacher (Tuesday)

Class times for grades 1 and 3-5 are 4:45 to 5:45 pm. Sunday classes for grade 2 are from 4:30-6:00 pm every other week. Class times for grades 6-9 are 6:00-7:00 pm.

You need not be an experienced teacher to volunteer. Training and materials will be provided. Please call 508-746-8268 if you are interested in working with the children of our parish.

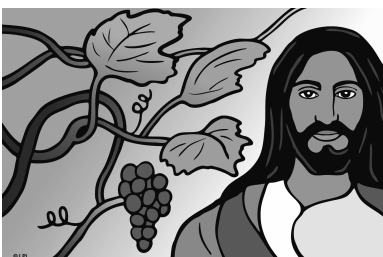
