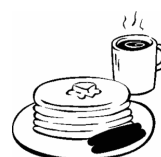
Anyone who would like to register their children for religious education classes in the fall should contact Karen LeBlanc or Carol Holland at 508-746-8268.

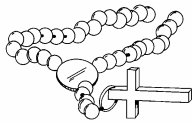


Memorial Day Mass at St. Joseph Cemetery

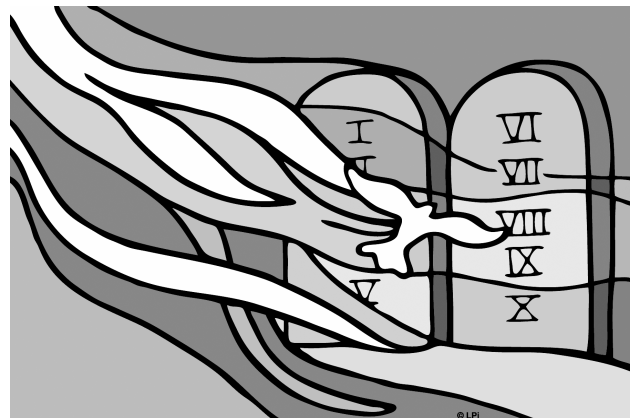
