**THE TEN COMMANDMENTS**

*Last week we covered the first three commandments.*

*Today we will discuss the Fourth Commandment.*

***Honor Your Father and Your Mother***

When God sent His Son into the world he sent him as a member of a family. Jesus had a human mother and a human foster-father and chose to be subject to them. By so doing he taught us the importance God places on the family. By his life at Nazareth as a member of the Holy Family, Christ has sanctified family life and given us an example of what that life should be. He taught us the dignity of parenthood by the reverence he showed to Mary and Joseph, whom he treated as the representatives of his Father.

By the Fourth commandment God reminds us that as his children we must respect authority within the family by honoring and obeying our parents. He reminds us, too, that we must respect and obey his other representatives who exercise lawful authority over us in the larger family of God.

**Whom Must We Obey?**

Children who are under age and still dependent on their parents must obey them in everything which is not in opposition to the laws of God.

We must obey the Church. Christ acts through the pope and through the spiritual ruler of the diocese, the bishop.

We must obey the civil government unless a law contradicts the laws of God. Whether a law binds us under sin or merely compels our obedience under the threat of a penalty depends on the specific circumstances.

The fourth commandment obliges us to fulfill our duties as citizens of our country, to respect its laws and institutions, to cooperate for the common good, and to love and defend our country when the cause and the means it uses are just.
