The second collection for St. James Society Missions was \$2,732.00.

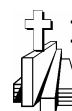

During the summer months the Religious Education Office will be open Monday – Thursday, 9:00 a. m. – 3:00 p.m.

Rosary for Life and Holy Hour will be held on Thursday mornings after the 9:00 am Mass to pray the Rosary for Life for the unborn and the safety of our armed forces.



The 4th of July is Sunday this year. In order to avoid conflict with the parade, we are changing our Mass schedule for that day: On Saturday, July 3rd, we will add a Mass at 5:30. On Sunday morning, we will have a second 9:00 Mass in the lower church. We will drop the 10:30 and 12:00 Mass that Sunday.

Sacrament of the Sick/Last Rites

The sacrament of the sick is a sacrament in which we pray for and anoint a person who is seriously ill. The prayer is for whatever kind of healing God wants to grant: physical, spiritual, or sometimes emotional. The "Last Rites" are those prayers we pray when someone is very close to death. Pastorally, celebrating these two special moments is best when the family is present, and ideally, if the sick person is conscious. However, the custom has been to wait until the last moment to send for the priest. Sometimes this eliminates family members from being present and the sick person who is not conscious from participating. *We want to encourage families to send for the priest earlier rather than later.* There are two practical reasons for this. First of all, the sick person can participate in the prayers and family members can be present. Secondly, there might not always be a priest immediately available if the family waits until "the last minute." There are just too few of us to be able to provide that level of service. So please, if there are sick people at home, let us bring the sacraments to them in a timely fashion.
