There are 755 priests who rely on the Clergy Fund to provide for their health care. In addition, there are 275 senior priests who rely on the clergy Funds for their retirement benefits. In recent years, the Clergy Funds have been stressed with the increase in medical costs and expenses growing faster than income. The need to stabilize this fund is critical and a top priority of Cardinal Sean and all of the priests.

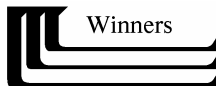
