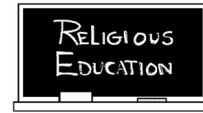

A discounted fee will be given to those registering prior to July 1st.

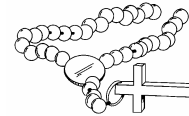


Teachers Needed !!!
