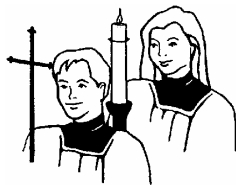

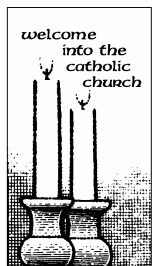

Outlines of the Catholic Faith from the catechism of the Catholic Church

Salvation History

- a. After the sin of Adam and Eve, and their fall from grace, God gave them the hope of salvation, by promising redemption.
- b. B. About the year 1850 B.C. God selected Abraham to be the father of the Israelites, his chosen people.
- c. C. Abraham had a son whom he called Isaac, and Isaac had Jacob who had twelve sons. The twelve tribes of Israel were named after Jacob's sons.
- d. D. In about the year 1250 B.C. God chose Moses to lead the Israelites out of their captivity in Egypt into the Promised Land.
- e. E. God gave the Ten Commandments to Moses on Mount Sinai and established a covenant with the people.
- f. F. God spoke to his people throughout the centuries through his prophets. The prophets continued to remind the people of their Covenant with God, of his commandments, and brought to them the message of salvation in the Messiah who was yet to come.
- g. When Christ, the Messiah came, he established a NEW COVENANT.
- h. People who follow the teachings of Jesus Christ are called Christians.
