## Outlines of the Catholic Faith from the Catechism of the Catholic Church Revelation

- A. The truths that God has revealed are found in **Sacred Scripture** and in **Sacred Tradition**.
- B. **Sacred Tradition** is the unwritten word of God given by Christ through the Holy Spirit to the Apostles and handed down to their successors. Sacred Tradition is revealed in the creeds, liturgy and prayers of the Church and in the authentic teachings of the Popes and the Bishops. Before the New Testament was written down it was transmitted orally and was part of Sacred Tradition.
- C. **Sacred Scripture** is the word of God written under the inspiration of the Holy Spirit and contained in the Holy Bible. It is the basic source of teaching in the Catholic Church.
- D. The Bible is divided into two books, the Old Testament and the New Testament.
- E. **The Old Testament** contains the revelation of God to the men and women who lived before the coming of Jesus Christ.
- F. **The New Testament** contains the words and deeds of Christ, the teachings of the Apostles, and their work in the early Church.

## The Chief Truths taught by Jesus Christ through the Catholic Church are contained in the Apostles' Creed.
