*From the Outlines of the Catholic Faith based on the Catechism of the Catholic Church.....*

The Chief Truths taught by Jesus Christ through the Catholic Church are contained in the Apostle's Creed.

**"He was conceived through the power of the Holy Spirit and born of the Virgin Mary".**

Jesus was not conceived through Joseph's seed. Still, Joseph is recognized as Jesus' human father. Joseph is told by the angel to name Jesus and at the finding in the temple; Mary calls Joseph, Jesus' father.

Jesus took upon himself a body and soul like ours in the womb of the Blessed Virgin Mary (INCARNATION) by the power of the Holy Spirit.

Jesus, the God-man, was born of the Virgin Mary in a stable in Bethlehem on Christmas Day.

**"He suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried.**

Christ suffered and died on the CROSS, in accordance with the Scriptures, for our sins and the sins of the whole world.

Pontius Pilate was the name of the Roman governor in Palestine under whom Jesus suffered and died.

The sufferings of Our Lord are called the Passion of Jesus Christ.

Jesus died on Mount Calvary on GOOD FRIDAY afternoon. Jesus is the Lamb of God, REDEEMER of man.

We honor the Sacred Passion when we make the SIGN OF THE CROSS.

We recall the Passion of Jesus in the STATIONS OF THE CROSS.

Jesus knew and loved us all when he offered his life.
