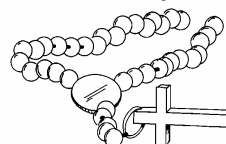

From the Outlines of the Catholic Faith based on the Catechism of the Catholic Church.....

The Chief Truths taught by Jesus Christ through the Catholic Church are contained in the

Apostle's Creed.

"I believe in the Holy Catholic Church, the communion of saints."

The sole Church of Christ subsists in the Catholic Church. The Church is One, Holy, Catholic and Apostolic. These are known as the **FOUR MARKS OF THE CHURCH.**

The Church is one God: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. Flowing from this one source is the unity of One Faith, One Baptism, One Sacrifice, and some Sacraments.

The Church is holy because Christ, the head of the Church, has made the Church holy through the gift of the Holy Spirit.

The Church is catholic or universal because Christ has given the Church the fullness of the means of salvation: correct and complete confession of faith, full sacramental life, and ordained ministry in apostolic succession. The Church is also catholic or universal because her mission is to preach the Gospel to the entire world.

The Church is apostolic because the Church continues the mission of the Apostles, because the Church continues to teach what the apostles taught, and because the Church continues to be guided by the apostles from heaven. The head of the church is its founder, Jesus Christ.

Christ appointed Saint Peter as the first visible head of the Church.

The Pope is the successor of Saint Peter and is the viable head of the Church.

The Pope and the Bishops are the lawful successors of the Apostles deriving from Christ the power to teach, to sanctify and to govern the faithful in spiritual matters.

The Church cannot err when teaching on faith or morals. **(INFAILLIBILITY)**

The **POPE** is infallible, when as the successor of St. Peter he solemnly defines a doctrine concerning faith or morals.

The Church as Christ founded it will last until the end of time.

After death, those who have died in God's grace and friendship but are not perfectly purified, undergo a final purification before they come to the glory of heaven. This purification is called **PURGATORY.**

The baptized faithful on earth (who are in the state of grace), the souls in purgatory and the saints and angels in heaven are in **COMMUNION** with each other, united together with Christ. This communion is called the **COMMUNION OF SAINTS.**

We honor the saints in heaven when we pray to them and ask them to pray and intercede for us.

We can assist the souls in purgatory by our prayers, fasting, and good works.

We can pray for one another on earth and assist each by performing the **SPIRITUAL** and **CORPORAL WORKS OF MERCY.**
