Last week's offertory collection was \$5,872.23

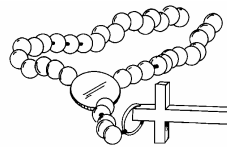

### *From the Outlines of the Catholic Faith based on the Catechism of the Catholic Church.....*

The Chief Truths taught by Jesus Christ through the Catholic Church are contained in the

#### **Apostle's Creed.**

**"I believe in the forgiveness of sins."**

Sin is a personal act which offends god, spiritually harms the sinner and others. It can be a thought, a word, a desire, and a deed. There are also sins of omission when we do not do what we should.

The first sin, committed by Adam and Eve, was **ORIGINAL SIN**.

In Adam and Eve, original sin was a personal sin.

Everyone born into the world, except Jesus and Mary, inherits original sin. Mary was conceived without sin as a special privilege called the Immaculate Conception. Jesus was conceived without sin because he is God and because he was conceived through the power of the Holy Spirit.

In us, original sin is the deprivation of original holiness and justice; sanctifying grace.

Original sin is removed by Baptism.

After original sin, many other sins were committed. These personal sins of Adam's descendents are called **ACTUAL SINS**.

Actual sins are committed by a person and are either **MORTAL** or **VENIAL**.

Mortal sin is committed when someone knowingly and in full freedom seriously violates one of God's commandments.

Mortal sins are forgiven through the Sacrament of Penance

Venial sin is a less serious offense against God.
