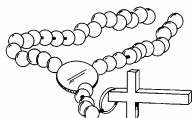

The collection for the Knights of Columbus Tootsie Roll Drive was \$472.00.

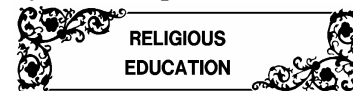
