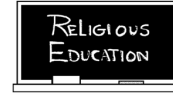

Next week's second collection will be for the Building Fund.



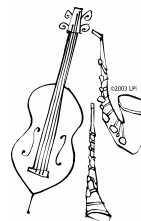
**On Wednesday, Nov. 11, 2009 there will be no religious education classes due to the observance of the Veteran's Day holiday.**

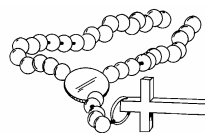

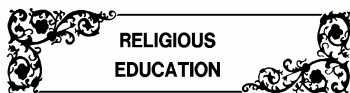
