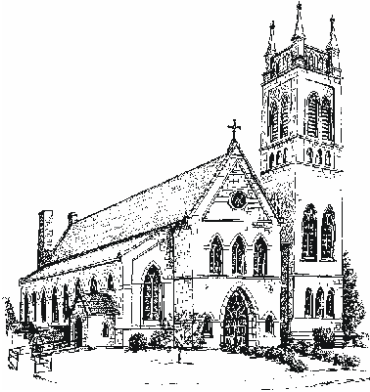

## UPDATING OUR CENSUS SECOND TRY

We had an excellent response to our first attempt at updating our census. More than 3,200 parishioners responded to the mailing. But we still have a long way to go. Our records contain over 7000 parishioners and it is critical that we are able to confirm their membership in Saint Mary's Parish.

In the past few weeks a second letter was sent to all those who have not yet responded. We really do hope to hear from you soon. As decisions are made for the distribution of Priests to various parishes in the future, accurate census information will be required. Pastoral planning requires that we have accurate information on which to use our limited resources. There are also simple, inexpensive ways to keep in touch with our parish family if we have accurate contact information. We do hope to hear from you very soon.

Dear friend of Saint Mary's,

Because we have you listed as an active member of Saint Mary of the Assumption parish, this past Easter you received a census renewal packet. More than 3,200 people have already responded to the census renewal. Unfortunately we have not heard from you so far. We are trying to keep this process as simple as possible. We need to confirm the membership status of everyone listed on our records and update family information when necessary.

First, please let us know if you still consider yourself a member of Saint Mary parish. If your membership status has changed please let us know so that we can update our membership records.

Hopefully, you still have your census packet. We realize in our busy lives such items can often end up in a "to do" pile. Please make any corrections and send it to us as soon as possible.

If you have misplaced your census packet please call the office at 508-473-2000 between 8:00 AM and 4:00 PM any weekday. We will either send you a new packet or if time permits update your family file over the phone.

Contact information such as your mailing address, telephone numbers and e-mail addresses are extremely important. The information you give us is **confidential** and will only be used for internal church use.

To update the census information for so many people is a massive undertaking. We do appreciate your participation and support. Your prompt cooperation will help Saint Mary's continue to build up the Body of Christ in our small part of the world.
