**WWJP “What Would Jesus Pray”**  
**– While the Crowds Cheered**  
John 17:1-20, Matthew 26:36-46

SERMON IN A NUTSHELL: The prayers of “the Man Jesus” often did not reflect the sentiments of the crowd, and at times they did not reflect the will of God – but Jesus talked it all over with His Father in Heaven. As a result of those open conversations, **our** relationship with God can be fully restored.

**INTRODUCTION:**

1. Prayer = Conversation with God
2. Palm Sunday / Holy Week / Easter  
= Public Religious Celebrations
3. 1<sup>st</sup> Palm Sunday = Preparing for Big Religious Holiday
4. While the crowds cheered – what were the prayers of Jesus?

**I. THE LAST DAYS (with Jesus)**

- A. Passover / The Last Supper  
- A time to remember & a time to look ahead
- B. Jesus’ Last Teachings
- C. Prayer together before He left

**II. THE LAST PRAYER MEETING**

- A. John 17:1-5 – Jesus prays for Himself
- B. John 17:6-19 – Jesus prays for His disciples
- C. John 17:20-25 – Jesus prays for all believers

**III. JUST BETWEEN GOD AND YOU**

- A. Luke 19:41-44 – The Crowd Cheers, but Jesus cries
- B. Matthew 26:36-46 – Jesus – “I Can’t do it”
- C. Best Friends (Church) let me down again
- D. BUT – I Trust you God - - -

**COMMUNION\***

- God didn’t answer all prayers of “the man Jesus” – because- --
  - God had a mission
  - Jesus said it was “Mission Impossible”
  - God said, “Trust My Will”
- Result – We come boldly into God’s presence

- \* We Remember that Great Day  
– “Thank God for unanswered prayer”
- \* We Delight in His Presence today
- \* We look forward to Jesus’ return and to Eternity with God in heaven
