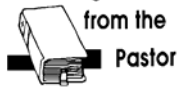

A Message



Dear parishioners,

This weekend you're invited to a special presentation: the unveiling of the current architectural plans for capital improvements to our parish. Everyone is invited to Msgr. Salemi Hall at 12:30 p.m. on Sunday June 22 for the program. This is designed to be the description of our "work in progress" ... this master plan now needs your feedback!

What we are working to do is address the various needs that parishioners identified in various ways over the past few years in regards to our structural facilities. The focus is on our lack of adequate meeting and classroom space, and the need to improve our church building.

Our Construction Committee and I spent weeks in study, discussion and planning with the architectural firm James Hundt Associates. Members of the Committee represent a variety of professional and parish interests, and include Phil Buttacavoli, Cindy Cavagrotti, James Cromie, Patrick Donahue, Mark Job, Lynn Novak, and Richard & Aleta Taylor. In addition, we have consulted with the co-chairs of our Campaign Cabinet: Tom & Judy Bruinooge and Jim & Danielle Carr. I hope you will take this opportunity to learn more about what we hope to accomplish. The meeting will highlight:

* **CHURCH:** more attractive and functional entrance and doors; roomier gathering space and seating area for toddlers; handicapped-accessible bathrooms; "stadium" seating in choir loft; more leg room in pews; more attractive and focused sanctuary arrangement, including handicapped accessibility for ambo (pulpit) and music ministry.

* **AUDITORIUM:** realignment of floor plan to include designated food pantry space and handicapped-accessible bathrooms; creation of second floor inside building with 10 meeting rooms (plus bathrooms, two stairways and elevator).

It will take our "time, talent and treasure" to make these dreams a reality. I firmly believe these efforts will help us be true to our Christian faith and help our parish thrive and grow. It can be a legacy we hand on, as we have benefited from those who have gone before us.
