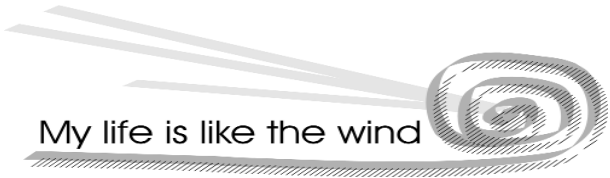

**WOMEN'S RETREAT**
