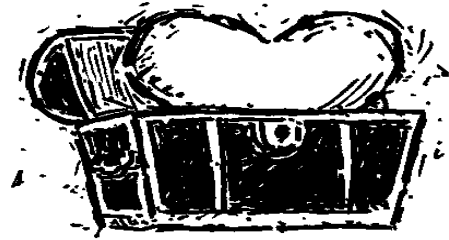

WIPE OUT!

Catholic Charities of the Diocese of Camden is working to Wipe Out Lead in Camden County. Even a small amount of lead can cause serious health problems in children, such as behavior problems; learning difficulties, hearing problems, brain damage, hyperactivity, anemia and slowed growth and development.

Through the Wipe Out Lead in New Jersey Program, sponsored by the New Jersey Department of Community Affairs, Catholic Charities is offering families FREE kits to test for the presence of lead dust in the home.

A safe and healthy home is the right of all children, and is necessary for children to grow, thrive and meet their full potential. To be eligible for a free kit, families must live in Camden County and live in a home or apartment built before 1978.

The test will be completed in a 5-10 minute visit to your home and is analyzed by a professional laboratory. To arrange to have a free test done in your home, contact Christine Polit at 856-278-2608.
