BAPTISMS: Parents should make arrangements with one of the priests at least one month before the date wanted. Baptism is celebrated on the FIRST and THIRD Sundays of the month at 12:30 P.M. Preparation is held on the SECOND THURSDAY of each month, 7:30 P.M., in the Rectory. Godparents must be practicing the faith and present a note from their parish on their eligibility as sponsors. No date can be set for baptism until parents have fulfilled these responsibilities.

MATRIMONY: To set a date for a wedding, couples must make an appointment at the Rectory at least 6 months prior to the wedding date. Weddings can be scheduled for most Saturdays any time until 2:00 P.M. or on any weekday.

Going to the Hospital?

If you **know ahead of time** that you will have to go to the hospital, we invite you to receive the **Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick** before you go.

Before or after Mass mention to one of us priests that you are going to the hospital and we will be happy to anoint you for spiritual strengthening.

In the Archdiocese **every hospital and institution has priests assigned as chaplains**. Catholic Hospitals have their own priest-chaplains; non-Catholic hospitals have pastoral care provided by priests and Eucharistic ministers from a near-by parish. This is to assure more frequent visits than your parish can provide.

When you check into a hospital, be sure to let admissions know that you are Catholic. Ask at the nursing station about receiving Holy Communion during your stay.

Please let us know you are in the hospital so that we may visit and ask parishioners to pray for you. Sometimes families **presume that we know when we do not**. We do not go to any of the hospitals unless we **know** a parishioner is there.

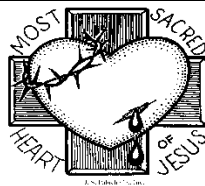

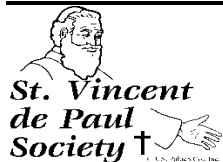
