Time to give money to the Lenten mission jar

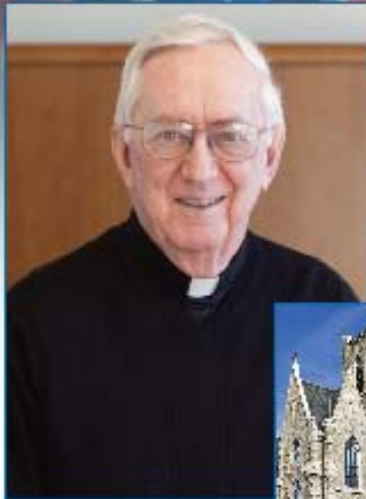
