**WELCOME**

We are happy to welcome to St. Mary Star of The Sea Parish Mr. Kwang Lee, Kwang is a Seminarian studying for the Archdiocese of Boston. He was raised in Oklahoma, attended college at the University of Michigan, and came to Boston in the fall of 2000 to study Ocean Engineering at MIT. In 2005 he entered St. John's Seminary. He will be with us this summer for eight weeks and will be with us during the school year a few hours each week. Please welcome Kwang and pray for him as he continues his priestly formation.

**The means to obtain the indulgence are as follows:**

All truly penitent priests who, on any day, devotedly pray Lauds or Vespers before the Blessed Sacrament exposed to public adoration or in the tabernacle, and ... offer themselves with a ready and generous heart for the celebration of the Sacraments, especially the Sacrament of Penance, will be granted a Plenary Indulgence, which they can also apply to their deceased confreres, if in accordance with current norms they take Sacramental Confession and the Eucharist and pray in accordance with the intentions of the Supreme Pontiff. Priests are furthermore granted a Partial Indulgence, also applicable to deceased confreres, every time they devotedly recite the prayers duly approved to lead a saintly life and to carry out the duties entrusted to them.

All truly penitent Christian faithful who, in church or oratory, devotedly attend Holy Mass and offer prayers to Jesus Christ, supreme and eternal Priest, for the priests of the Church, or perform any good work to sanctify and mold them to His Heart, are granted a Plenary Indulgence, on the condition that they have expiated their sins through Sacramental Confession and prayed in accordance with the intentions of the Supreme Pontiff. This may be done on the opening and closing days of the Year of Priests, on the 150th anniversary of the death of St. Jean Marie Vianney, on the first Thursday of the month, or on any other day established by the ordinaries of particular places for the good of the faithful.

The elderly, the sick and all those who for any legitimate reason are unable to leave their homes, may still obtain a plenary indulgence if, with the soul completely removed from attachment to any form of sin and with the intention of observing, as soon as they can, the usual three conditions, "on the days concerned, they pray for the sanctification of priests and offer their sickness and suffering to God through Mary, Queen of the Apostles."

Additionally, a partial indulgence will be offered to the faithful each time they pray five "Our Father," "Hail Mary" and "Glory Be," or any other duly approved prayer "in honor of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, to ask that priests maintain purity and sanctity of life."

Dear Friends in Christ,

In his homily for Pentecost, Pope Benedict XVI said that the scriptures tell us how the community must be in order to receive the Holy Spirit. "They all persevered in concord and prayer" (Acts 1:14). The Holy Father goes on to say, "So, the concord of the disciples is the condition for the coming of the Holy Spirit; and prayer is the presupposition of concord." In other words, in order for the Spirit to do his work in and through us, we need to be one in heart and mind. In order for us to be one in heart and mind, we need to deepen our life of prayer. The Holy Father said that perhaps the Church right now needs to be less preoccupied with "activities" and more dedicated to prayer.

Beginning on Friday June 19<sup>th</sup>—the Feast of the Sacred Heart of Jesus—the Church will celebrate the "Year of the Priest." The purpose of this special year is for the whole Church to pray for the sanctification of its priests. As you know, for a year now, our chapel in the lower church has been set aside for Eucharistic Adoration with the specific purpose of praying for vocations and for the sanctification of the clergy. During the Year of the Priest, St. Mary Star of the Sea Church will be particularly set aside for these intentions. During the year, there will be various opportunities in addition to our daily adoration for parishioners and other faithful of the Archdiocese to come here and pray for priests.

I humbly ask you to give yourself over to this special mission that has been entrusted to us this year. We need holy priests. Speaking for myself, I know that I am a better priest when I am a holy priest. And, I also know that parishes, dioceses, and communities are strengthened when their priests are holy priests. The year provides an opportunity to those of us who are priests to draw closer in our union with Christ, the Great High Priest. It provides to the laity an opportunity to help their priests by praying for them.

The Holy Father, Pope Benedict XVI has granted the attachment of an indulgence to the Year of the Priest. What exactly is an indulgence? Well, when we sin—even after the guilt for that sin has been forgiven through Confession—there still remains the need to make reparation for that sin. I often use this silly example: If I punch you in the face and then say I am sorry, you can forgive me. But, in justice, I still have to pay for your hospital bill. In the same way, when we sin, that sin has effects in the world. And so, we must do penance in order to satisfy the demands of justice. We can either satisfy those demands here on earth or in purgatory.

An indulgence basically is a great act of mercy that helps us to satisfy those demands more easily. (For the sake of space here, I am shortchanging a fuller explanation on what indulgences are.) There are two types of indulgence. They are called "plenary" and "partial." The Plenary Indulgence—when granted—is for the full remission of all the punishments due to sin. In other words, we satisfy ALL the demands of justice from our past sins. The Partial Indulgence satisfies some of those demands.

During the Year of the Priest there are opportunities both for priests and for the lay faithful to obtain indulgences. There are certain conditions that have to be met. These conditions will be outlined elsewhere in the bulletin. The first day on which the Plenary Indulgence can be granted will be on June 19<sup>th</sup>, the Feast of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. On that day, I encourage you to come to the 7am Mass. Also, that evening, from 6:30-7:30pm, we will have a Holy Hour with the Rosary and Benediction to begin the Year of the Priest. I would be grateful if you would consider coming to that and praying for priests and for vocations to the priesthood.

May this year be a time for us to persevere in our friendship with one another and to persevere in our prayer and may our perseverance be rewarded with the outpouring of the Holy Spirit for the sanctification of the clergy and for the increase of priestly vocations.
