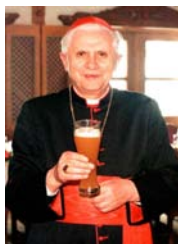
**A Prayer for Priest**

O Almighty Eternal God, look upon the face of Thy Son, and for the love of Him who is the eternal High Priest, have pity on Thy priests. Remember, O most compassionate God, that they are but weak and frail human beings. Stir up in them the grace of their vocation which is in them by the imposition of the bishop's hands. Keep them close to Thee, lest the enemy prevail against them, so that they may never do anything in the slightest degree unworthy of their sublime vocation.

O Jesus, I pray Thee for Thy faithful and fervent priests; for Thy unfaithful and tepid priests; for Thy priests laboring at home or abroad in distant mission fields; for Thy tempted priests; for Thy lonely priests; for Thy dying priests; for the souls of Thy priests in purgatory. But above all I commend to Thee the priests dearest to me; the priest who baptized me; the priests who absolved me from my sins; the priests at whose Masses I assisted, and who gave me Thy Body and Blood in Holy Communion; the priests who taught and instructed me, or helped and encouraged me; all the priests to whom I am indebted in any other way, particularly (Names of particular Priests). O Jesus, keep them all close to Thy Heart, and bless them abundantly in time and in eternity. Amen.

THANK YOU!

Dear Friends in Christ,

This coming Friday—the Feast of the Sacred Heart—marks the beginning day of the Year of the Priest. For the entire year, Catholics are asked to pray for their priests so that their priests might grow in sanctity. The holier we priests are, the better off our parishes are. So, I hope that you will be generous in supporting this endeavor. Our parish's adoration chapel has been designated as one place where the people of the Archdiocese can come to pray for this important intention.

As I mentioned last week, Pope Benedict XVI has granted a plenary indulgence to those who meet certain requirements during certain days of the Year of the Priest. The first of those days will be this coming Friday.

*"The Plenary Indulgence is granted to all the faithful who are truly repentant who, in church or in chapel, devoutly attend the divine Sacrifice of Mass and offer prayers to Jesus Christ the Eternal High Priest, for the priests of the Church, and any other good work which they have done on that day, so that he may sanctify them and form them in accordance with His Heart, as long as they have made expiation for their sins through sacramental confession and prayed in accordance with the Supreme Pontiff's intentions: on the days in which the Year for Priests begins and ends, on the day of the 150th anniversary of the pious passing of St John Mary Vianney, on the first Thursday of the month or on any other day established by the local Ordinaries for the benefit of the faithful"*

Translation: In order to receive the Plenary Indulgence this Friday, a person would need to be truly repentant of their sins, participate in the Sacrifice of the Mass on Friday, offer prayers to Jesus Christ the Eternal High Priest, for the priests of the Church, and offer some good work that day for the purpose of sanctifying the priests of the Church. That good work could be prayer, an act of charity etc. One must also have confessed all sins in sacramental confession and prayed for the intentions of the Pope.

With these conditions all met, a person could gain the Plenary Indulgence (the remission of all the temporal punishments due to past sins) either for himself or for somebody who is deceased.

In order to help as many of you as possible to receive the Indulgence on June 19<sup>th</sup>, I will do the following:

On Thursday evening June 18<sup>th</sup>, I will be available for confessions in the adoration chapel from 6:30pm—7:30pm. On the morning of Friday June 19<sup>th</sup>, I will be available for confessions in the adoration chapel from 6:15am until 6:45am. In the evening of June 19<sup>th</sup>, there will be a Holy Hour from 6:30pm-7:30pm including the recitation of the Rosary for the sanctification of the clergy and at 7:30pm we will conclude the Holy Hour by offering the Mass. During the Holy Hour, from 6:30-7:15pm, I will be available for confessions.

These opportunities to go to confession, and to attend Mass either at 7am or 7pm on Friday June 19<sup>th</sup> ought to make it easier for many of you to be able to receive the Indulgence and to pray for the priests of the Church. I hope that you will take advantage of this great opportunity.

As a somewhat related note, I would like to extend my gratitude to you for the life we live together as a Catholic community. It's a real honor.
