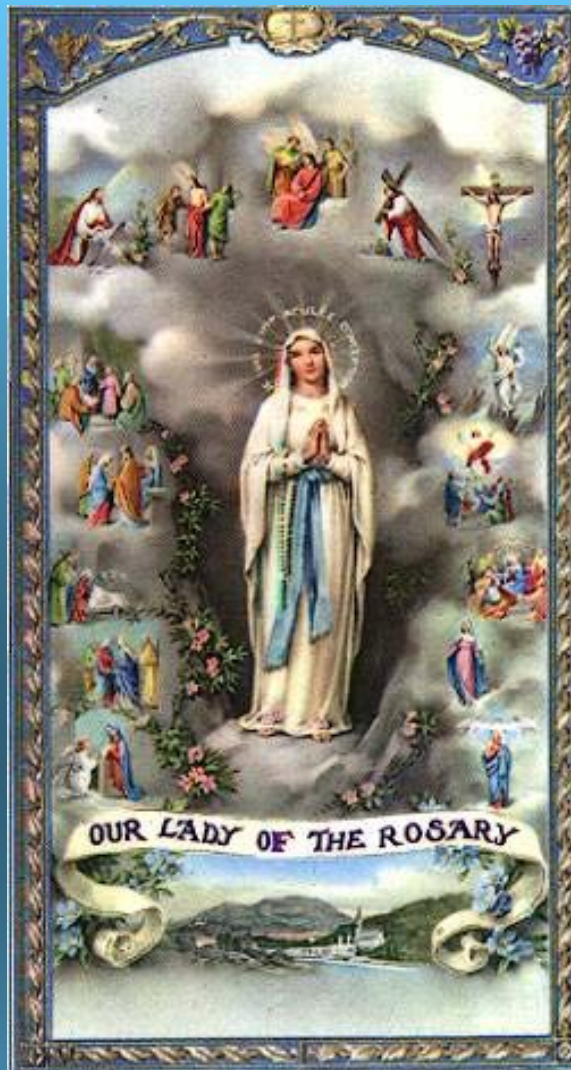

Are afraid to go to Confession or haven't been in a long time, Jesus the Good Shepherd is looking for you.

Feel like your marriage is in trouble, Jesus the Good Shepherd is looking for you.

Are addicted to alcohol or drugs, Jesus the Good Shepherd is looking for you.

Are considering doing harm to yourself or to another, Jesus the Good Shepherd is looking for you.

Are afraid to end a sinful relationship, Jesus the Good Shepherd is looking for you.

Feel all alone in your suffering, Jesus the Good Shepherd is looking for you.

Are immersed in pornography and masturbation, Jesus the Good Shepherd is looking for you.

Are carrying the burdens of anger, resentment, and hatred, Jesus the Good Shepherd is looking for you.

Are embarrassed about some situation in your life and it is keeping you from moving forward in your Christian life, Jesus the Good Shepherd is looking for you.

Participated in an abortion and have never confessed it, Jesus the Good Shepherd is looking for you.

Have drifted away from the Faith and the practice of the Faith and seem like you are just unable to truly "get back into it," Jesus the Good Shepherd is looking for you.

I am certain that there are many other things that could be listed here. Experience teaches that these are just some of the more common reasons why people feel so lost and alone.

Jesus cares about the one, loves the one, and seeks out the one. If you are the one, don't be ashamed to let him find you.
