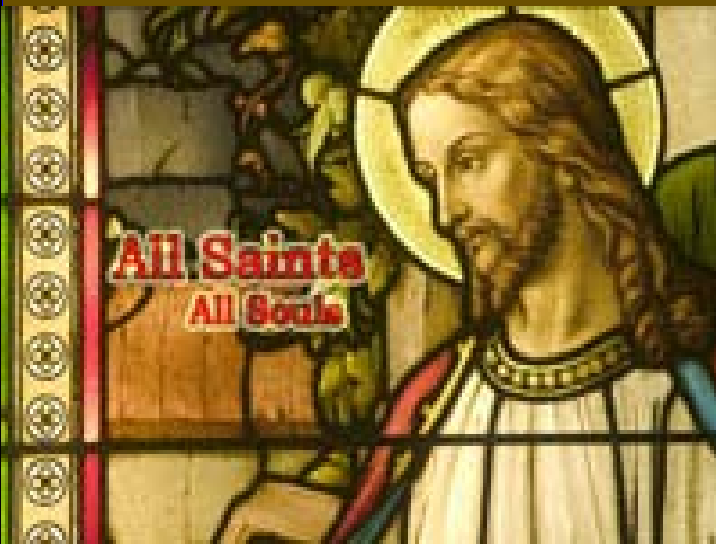

Dear Friends in Christ,

- ◆ Thanks to all of you who have already contributed to the Grand Annual Collection. Your generous and speedy response is heartening. We still have quite a ways to go before we reach our goal, but thanks to so many of you, we are on our way. Thank You.
- ◆ I particularly want to thank those new givers to the Grand Annual. It was very encouraging to see some new young parishioners contributing.
- ◆ I extend my thanks to all of the children in our Religious Education program and at St. Mary's School for all of the prayers that they offered to me as a gift for World Priest Sunday last week. I believe the number was somewhere around 4000 Our Father's, Hail Mary's, and Glory Be's. I certainly appreciate those prayers.
- ◆ November is a month when we traditionally pray for the Dead. A very traditional prayer that is prayed for the Dead is the following:

Leader: Eternal rest grant unto them O Lord

Response: And let perpetual light shine upon them.

Leader: May they rest in peace.

Response: Amen.

Leader: May their souls and all of the souls of the Faithful Departed through the mercy of God rest in peace.

Response: Amen.

Consider teaching that prayer to your children. Perhaps use it at the end of meals during November. We ought to pray for our deceased relatives and friends, have Masses offered for them, and visit their graves.

- ◆ **USHERS:** At the back of church this weekend there is a sign-up sheet so that we can have a better sense of who our ushers are and a way of getting in touch with you. If you currently serve as an usher at our Masses or would like to be on the list, please fill out the information requested. There are points of information that we need to pass along to the ushers but right now have no contact info. Thank you.

#### Some Gentle Reminders:

- ◆ The back of the church and the chapel downstairs sometimes look like a religious Sanford & Son from all of the religious books, cards, medals, and articles that are left there. Please do not leave such things around the church. Thanks.
- ◆ If you arrive to Mass as the procession is making its way up the middle aisle, please do not follow behind the priest. Please either wait until the priest has arrived at his seat or simply go up the side aisle.
- ◆ Parents of young children, please try to teach them that they should not be making frequent trips to the bathroom during the Mass. Particularly, once the Eucharistic Prayer has begun, unless there is an emergency, everybody should be kneeling and being attentive to the Consecration. If you miss the Consecration during Mass, you have missed the most important part of the Mass. Also, parents of young children—please accompany your children to the bathroom. We do not want children left unattended. Please be attentive to this.
- ◆ **THANKSGIVING MASS:** In the past, we have offered a Mass on the Wednesday evening before Thanksgiving. The purpose of having Mass at that time was simply to make it more convenient for those who were traveling. But, experience has shown that Mass to be poorly attended. Therefore, there will be no Mass on the Wednesday night before Thanksgiving. **THERE WILL BE MASS AT 8AM ON THANKSGIVING DAY.**
