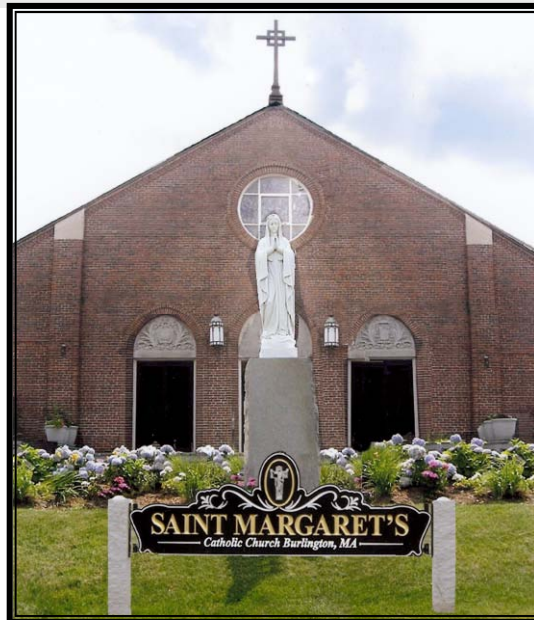

Dear Parishioners:

Wednesday, November 11, 2009 is Veterans Day. There ought not be a day that passes that we don't remember those who have served and those who continue to serve this great nation. As much an apparent contradiction "peace through war" has become, never-the-less it is reality. Any young person volunteering for military duty today does so under the threat of going to battle. This is not peace-time. I pray I never have to officiate at the funeral of a loved one or a parishioner who died in the line of duty. The grief associated with death from war is very painful and long-lasting. Enlisting is a most serious decision by our young people. The repercussions could be life-threatening. All veterans need our thoughtful appreciation and our daily prayers.

St. Margaret's is a handicap accessible church. Our elevator goes to both the upper and lower churches. Please encourage those confined to home to consider coming with you to church. We have plenty of space for wheel-chairs. What a great opportunity to get out of the house!

All scheduled projects have been completed. Only time will tell how successful they will be. The front stairs were removed, the bedding dug out, a weather proof membrane and a new layer of mortar were applied as each piece of granite was reset, and we opted not to use any caulking. We then covered everything with two coats of water-proof material. Let's hope this lasts for a very long time!!

The garage roof has been finished with architectural shingles that match the rectory roof. All roofs on our campus are a matching gray in color. Take a ride up on the hill for a beautiful view of our facilities. Better still take a walk! There is a bench at the Crucifixion scene where you can rest and enjoy the silence.

All the windows of the school have been caulked, a rather tedious job. The outside metal has been painted a deep bronze color with two coats of rust-inhibitive paint. The outside of the school hall and barn were painted this past summer. Appearance-wise things look good. We will try to hibernate for the winter and hope nothing goes wrong.

Thank you to all who were responsible for the Mass of Remembrance last Sunday. To those of you who lost loved ones this past year, be assured that Father Harry and myself will remember them throughout the year.

- Baptism** On the second and fourth Sundays of the month at 2:00 p.m. Please call for an interview with any priest at the rectory to fill out the baptismal form. If you have a priest coming for the Baptism, you are most welcome to schedule the Baptism at your convenience.
- Confirmation** Begins in the Ninth Grade and concludes in the Tenth Grade. Attendance includes class, liturgy, and ministry.
- Penance** Every Saturday in the lower church from 3:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m.
- Marriage** Congratulations on your engagement ! Please schedule an appointment with a priest at least 6 months prior to the wedding. Engaged couples contemplating marriage are required to take a marriage preparation course. Available programs may be found on the Family Life website (www.familylifeboston.com) or by calling 617-746-5801.
- Anointing** Please call the rectory and we will visit at home. If anyone is confined to the house and would like to receive a Communion visit, please call us. Our eucharistic ministers assist us in these visits.
- Funerals** Arrangements are made through the funeral directors. They are most compassionate and experienced, and will be of great assistance to you at this particular time in your life. A priest from St. Margaret's will lead a prayer service at the wake and graveside, as well as preside at the Funeral Mass. Our parish hall is available after the funeral, if needed.

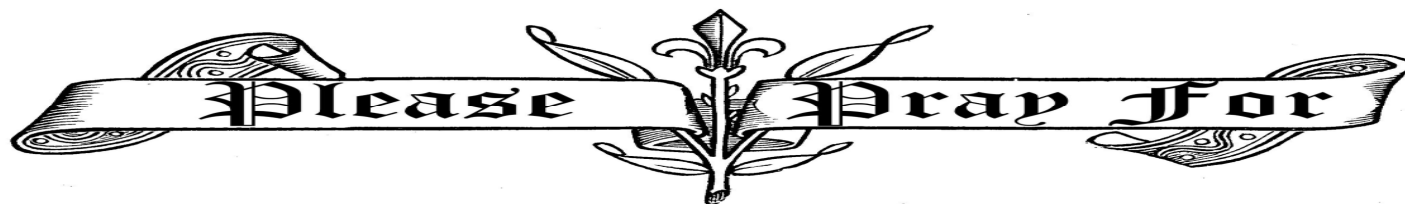
Having finalized our 2009-2010 St. Margaret's budget, our Finance Council estimates the parish needs \$10,500 per week in revenue to avoid running a deficit.
