On June 9, 2012 the Columbiettes and Knights of Columbus of St. Sylvester Catholic Church in Gulf Breeze, Florida are planning a Flag Day 5K Run/Walk to benefit 3 local charities. The charities are the Special Operations Warrior Foundation, Spectrum House Autism Center in Navarre, and the Santa Rosa County Guardian Ad Litem Program. All of these organizations benefit children. The Special Operations Warrior Foundation provides scholarships and educational counseling to the children of fallen or severely wounded Special Operations military personnel. Spectrum House Autism Center provides behavioral and educational services to children with Autism, ADHD, and Downs Syndrome so they can develop to their full potential. The Guardian Ad Litem Program is an organization of volunteers who are appointed by the Court to represent abused and neglected children in court. We are asking the area's businesses to assist us in this endeavor by making a donation. A donation will help defray some of the expenses of the race and maximize our charitable donation. Our expenses include: awards, T-shirts, food, bottled water, police security, medical support, and advertising. If you can help by making a financial donation, our organizations would very much appreciate it.
