ITINERARY

Day 1 November 5, Monday: Depart USA

This afternoon, depart Salt Lake City and Atlanta Hartsfield-Jackson International Airport via Delta Airlines for your transatlantic flight to the Holy Land. Complimentary meals and beverages will be served aloft. (D,B,L)

Day 2 November 6, Tuesday: Arrive in the Land of the Bible

This afternoon, arrive at Ben Gurion Tel Aviv Airport. You will be met and assisted by a Passages by Peter's Way tour manager. Board your comfortable motor coach and soon, you will be on your way to check-in at hotel. After dinner, enjoy an evening orientation, introducing you to the historical and geographical setting of the New Testament. Overnight at hotel in Tel Aviv. (D)

Day 3 November 7, Wednesday: Caesarea - Mt. Carmel - Nazareth - Cana - Sea of Galilee

This morning, after breakfast, we will drive along the scenic Mediterranean, stopping at Caesarea by the Sea. Visit includes the Theatre, newly excavated Palace, Hippodrome and the Harbor. Continue to Mt. Carmel (*Vineyard of God*) on the Mediterranean Coast. Visit Stella Maris, the largest monastery of the Carmelite order, dedicated to the prophet Elijah and Mary, Our Lady of Mount Carmel. **Time will be given for prayer and reflection at the Monastery.** Independent lunch.

After lunch, continue to Nazareth, the village in which Jesus grew up and lived most of His life. **Celebrate Mass at the Grotto of the Annunciation.**

After Mass, visit Joseph's workshop and explore the magnificent Basilica of the Annunciation, Mary's Well, and the Church of the Old Synagogue, which marks the beginning of Jesus' public ministry. Walk through the streets and imagine a day in the life of the Holy Family of Nazareth.

Continue to the nearby village of Cana, where Jesus performed His first miracle. **Couples will have an opportunity to renew their wedding vows.** Continue to the unforgettable Sea of Galilee for hotel check-in. (B,D)

Day 4 November 8, Thursday: Around the Sea of Galilee - Upper Galilee - Jordan River

After breakfast, this morning's boat ride on the Sea of Galilee will be among your favorite memories.

Arrive at the ancient city of Capernaum, where Jesus started His ministry. Here, the excellent condition of a second century synagogue undoubtedly enclosed the sacred sanctuary in which Jesus taught and preached. At Tabgha, Jesus challenged His disciples to feed a crowd of 5,000 in the Multiplication of Loaves and Fishes. We also visit the Church of the Primacy. Continue to visit the Mount of the Beatitudes, where Jesus offered His *'Sermon on the Mount.'* **Celebrate Mass on the Mt. of Beatitudes.**

Independent lunch. (Perhaps you will want to try delicious St. Peter's Fish!)

This afternoon, drive north to explore the upper regions of Israel to the foot of Mount Hermon, overlooking Syria and the Road to Damascus, where Jesus appeared to Paul and the site where Jesus asked His disciples and each one of us, "Who do you say that I am?" **The day will climax at the River Jordan, where there will be the opportunity for the renewal of Baptismal promises (Mark 1:9-11).** (B,D)

Day 5 November 9, Friday: Sepphoris - Ibillin - Mt. Tabor - Beit Shean - Megiddo

Breakfast at your hotel. Today's bus journey is filled with variety and excitement. Begin our day with a visit to Sepphoris, where tradition locates the home of Joachim and Anna, Mary's parents. View recent archeological digs. The "Mona Lisa of Israel" was unearthed here.

Continue to visit the little village of Ibillin. Visit the Mar Elias School and Educational Institutions (MEEI). Independent lunch.

This afternoon, we continue to visit Mt. Tabor. Take a taxi to the top of Mt. Tabor. It was here that Jesus revealed His glory and divinity to Peter, James and John. **Visit**

the site of the Transfiguration and Celebrate Mass. Continue to the town of Beit Shean. Visit the incredible remains of the Biblical city of Beit Shean - Israel's best example of how Jerusalem looked in the times of Jesus. Our final stop this afternoon will be Megiddo, the site of numerous decisive battles throughout history. Visit the remains of ancient temples that date back over 4,000 years. (B,D)

Day 6 November 10, Saturday: Cross to Jordan - Jerash - Petra

After early breakfast, **celebrate Mass at the Church of the Primacy.**

After Mass, we drive to the Sheikh Hussein Northern Border bridge, pass border formalities and meet the Jordanian guide and driver, and be on our way to visit Jerash. We'll begin at the visitors' center by visiting the two major monuments outside the city walls - The Hadrian Arch and the Hippodrome (we'll note the Christian churches that are built on its sides). We'll enter the walled city by going through the south gate, then into the Forum (oval plaza area) that is surrounded by ionic capitals, which is the introduction to the colonnaded street. We'll walk to Zeus' temple and the south theater and down to the Cardo, a street that runs south north in the Roman city. We'll see shops on both sides of the Cardo as we visit the cathedral, the Nymphaeum, and Artemis' temple, and then walk up to visit the churches that are covered with mosaic floors. Independent lunch.

After lunch we drive along the modern highway built over the "Kings Highway" to Petra, the "Rose-red city."

Dinner and overnight at hotel in Petra. (B,D)

Day 7 November 11, Sunday: AM/Enjoy Petra - PM/Amman

After breakfast, a short carriage ride through the narrow 'Siq' will bring us to the ancient Nabatean city of Petra, a city which is sculpted into the rose pink rock. A walk through the outer Siq brings us to monuments, which are basically the treasury and the tombs. The Street of Façades is the first one and was for poor people. Further down we come to the theater, which is carved into the mountain and contains the "high place of sacrifice." The theater, which accommodates 7,000 persons, apparently was not utilized only for acting, but also for celebrating the gods, as there is an altar in the heart of the theater for rituals. In the eastern cliff, we'll view the Royal Tombs (the URN, the SILK, the Corinthian and Palace tombs). Further down, we can visit more temples and even a church with mosaic floor. Independent lunch. After lunch, we leave Petra and drive north for Amman, biblical city of Rabbah, capital city of Jordan. Visit the beautiful 2nd century Roman Amphitheater in the center of town.

Celebrate Mass at the Franciscan Church in Amman.

Dinner and overnight at hotel in Amman. (B,D)

Day 8 November 12, Monday: Madaba - Mt. Nebo - Baptismal Site - Ein Gedi - Dead Sea Area

Breakfast at your hotel. Afterward, we leave Amman to visit Madaba, city of mosaics. We'll see mosaics depicting Jerusalem and Palestine at the time of Justinian, and what is possibly the oldest existing map of the Holy Land. Then, we continue to visit Mount Nebo, to stand where Moses stood and gazed across the Jordan Valley. If the day is clear we'll be able to see as far as Jerusalem, the Dead Sea, the Jordan Valley and the Gilead Mountains. **Celebrate Mass at the Franciscan Monastery on Mt. Nebo.**

Continue to visit Machaerus, where John the Baptist was held captive and later beheaded, and continue to the site where the baptism of Jesus took place. We'll continue to Amman to visit the beautiful 2nd century Roman Amphitheater in the center of town. Independent lunch.

After crossing over the Allenby Bridge into Israel, we'll pass border formalities and meet our Israeli guide and driver, and be on our way to the Judean Wilderness for one of the most unique locations on the planet earth - the Dead Sea. On its shores, we will visit Ein Gedi, where David hid from Saul's wrath and the locale of the Song of Songs. A synagogue mosaic remains from Ein Gedi's heyday. Check-in at hotel in the Dead Sea Resort.

Dinner and overnight at hotel near the Dead Sea. (B,D)

Day 9 November 13, Tuesday: Masada – Shepherd’s Field & Bethlehem

Breakfast at your hotel. Morning at leisure (perhaps, you would like to bathe in the Dead Sea). Late morning, take a cable car ride to the ruins of Herod’s palace-fortress atop Masada. Visit the ruins of the fortifications, reservoirs for water, Herodian palaces, synagogue, Roman temples and baths.

This afternoon, drive to the hills of Bethlehem. Upon arrival, we will visit Shepherd’s Field, where you will see caves which are typical of the stables of that time. The highlight of our time in Bethlehem will be a visit to the traditional birth-place of Jesus, in the Basilica of the Nativity. Here, the Prince of Peace was born! Venerate the silver star that marks the place where the sublime mystery of the Incarnation was revealed in a manger! Let us kneel down and lift our hearts and voices in song, as we imagine that holy “*Silent Night*.” Free time will be given for shopping and browsing in Manger Square. **Celebrate Mass at St. Catherine Church or St. Jerome Chapel.** After Mass, we will visit Bethlehem University, the only Catholic institution of higher education in the Holy Land. Dinner and overnight at hotel in Jerusalem. (B,D)

Day 10 November 14, Wednesday: Ein Kerem - New City

Breakfast at your hotel. Begin our day with a visit to the village of Ein Kerem, home of Elizabeth, Mary’s kinswoman, and Zachariah. It is also the birthplace of John the Baptist. **Celebrate Mass at the Church of the Visitation.** Following Mass, we will take a few moments for quiet reflection on the meeting between the two mothers, Mary and Elizabeth. Then, proceed to Yad Vashem, memorial to the Holocaust. Visit the Museum, Childrens’ Pavilion and walk along the Avenue of the Righteous. Then we’ll visit the Hadassah Medical Center to view Marc Chagall’s stained-glass windows at the Hospital synagogue.

This afternoon, we visit the Israel Museum, which contains the Shrine of the Book, where the Dead Sea Scrolls are displayed in a beautiful building simulating the Qumran caves. There we’ll also visit the scale model of first century Jerusalem. Our guide will walk us through an accurately detailed scale model of Jerusalem of Biblical times, which includes details of the architecture and décor of the Temple. Dinner and overnight at hotel in Jerusalem. (B,D)

Day 11 November 15, Thursday: Today is Dedicated to the City of David and Tour of the Western Wall Tunnels

Breakfast at your hotel. **After breakfast we will begin our day with Mass at the Franciscan Church of the Cenacle.** Today is dedicated to explore the City of David, which was founded more than 3,000 years ago when King David left Hebron for a small hilltop city now known as Jerusalem. We’ll walk through the dry tunnel. The massive destruction of Jerusalem by the Babylonians can be seen in the layers of the charred remains and thick layer of rubble from the collapsed buildings. Then we’ll visit the Jewish Quarter, the Cardo, and the Western Wall of the Temple Mount. Above the Temple foundations, we view the El Aksa Mosque and the Dome of the Rock. Then we’ll proceed to the nearby Southern Wall Excavations. Independent lunch. This afternoon, we tour the western wall tunnels. These underground tunnels connect the western wall prayer area to the northwest side of the temple mount, passing along the side of the temple mount and under the present day houses in the Old City. The underground tunnel at the center of the controversy was know officially in the 1980s as the “Western Wall Tunnel.” Dinner and overnight at hotel in Jerusalem. (B,D)

Day 12 November 16, Friday: Mt. Of Olives – Mt. Zion

Breakfast at your hotel. **Celebrate Mass at the Church of Lazarus in Bethany.** After Mass, visit to the Mt. of Olives. Visit the Chapel of the Ascension, the Shrine of Pater Noster and the Chapel of Dominus Flevit (*The Lord Wept*). Then, follow Jesus’ Palm Sunday route along Hosanna Road to the Garden of Gethsemane to visit the Grotto, the Garden and the Church of the Agony (Church of All Nations). Continue to Mt. Zion, for a visit to the Church of St. Peter-in-Gallicantu. Here, Jesus was imprisoned and Peter denied the Lord three times. Next, we visit the Upper Room, site of the Last Supper and descent of the Holy Spirit upon the Apostles. Then, visit the Dormition Abbey, built to honor the Assumption of Our Lady. Independent lunch and balance of the day at leisure. Dinner and overnight at hotel in Jerusalem. (B,D)

Day 13 November 17, Saturday: AM/ Via Dolorosa - PM/Emmaus – Evening/Return to the USA

Leisurely breakfast at your hotel. After breakfast, drive to the Old City and enter through St. Stephen’s Gate to visit the Crusader Church of St. Anne and explore the Pool of Bethesda. Continue to the convent of the Sisters of Zion to see the Lithostrotos in the chapel of the Flagellation, where Jesus was tried and condemned by Pilate. Then, we will carry the Cross and pray the Stations of the Cross as we retrace Jesus’ last steps before His Crucifixion along the Via Crucis, to the Church of the Holy Sepulchre. **Celebrate Mass at the Basilica of the Holy Sepulchre.** The afternoon is free for private devotions or shopping in the Old City. Independent lunch.

Optional afternoon visit to the site of Emmaus (Abu Gosh), and the Church of Our Lady of the Ark of the Covenant. Before our group dinner at the Ambassador hotel in Jerusalem, there will be an opportunity to freshen up for dinner and our return flight. After dinner, we will be transferred to Tel Aviv airport for our 1:00 am flight to Atlanta. (B,D)

Day 14 November 18, Sunday: Arrive in the USA

Early morning, arrive in Atlanta Airport, and connect to Delta flight to Salt Lake City. Late morning, arrive in Salt Lake City, filled to overflowing with memories that will change your life.

Additionally, if you purchase your own air transportation and the group does not materialize or you cancel your package for any reason, Passages by Peter's Way will not be held responsible for the cost of your airfare.

BAGGAGE ALLOWANCE: Due to bus space, one carry-on bag and one checked bag, per person, are permitted. Standard airline baggage policies usually allow checked baggage up to 62 total inches and range to 50 pounds and carry-on baggage up to 45 total inches and 11 to 40 pounds. However, policies may vary from the time of printing of this brochure. Contact your airline directly before departure for current baggage dimension allowances. For luggage exceeding the allowed limits, excess baggage fees will apply at check-in. Our final documents will contain current information applicable to your designated airline.

TRANSFER AND PORTERAGE: Round-trip private overseas transfers to/from hotel. Portage of one piece of luggage throughout your tour at hotels. Although the airlines will allow you to check two pieces of luggage, we strongly suggest that you travel with one suitcase and one carry-on.

SERVICE CHARGES FOR ITINERARY CHANGES: Passages by Peter's Way is pleased to assist clients with changes in itineraries (All deviation requests must be submitted in writing at least 90 days prior to departure). Deviation fee will apply, plus an airline change fee per person. Your routing and dates requested will determine if a difference in airfare will also apply. Not all carriers permit routing changes and/or deviations from the group itinerary. Please contact our office for detailed information.

LATE RESERVATIONS: A \$25.00 fee and possible increase in airfare may apply for bookings received after the deposit deadline. All space is subject to availability. A \$50.00 late payment fee and possible increase in airfare may apply for late payments. Reservations are subject to deadlines with airlines and various vendors. Special delivery charges incurred will also be due in advance.

PASSENGERS WITH SPECIAL NEEDS: The majority of our trips require a lot of walking, which may involve stairs, hills, cobblestone roads and uneven pavement. Additionally, most motor coaches are not equipped with wheelchair ramps. It is each passenger's responsibility to be aware of his or her limits with regard to travel and group activities. Any person with a disability requiring special attention must advise Passages by Peter's Way of the situation at time of enrollment. A qualified companion must accompany any passenger requiring special assistance. Passages by Peter's Way will make reasonable attempts to accommodate disabled passengers with special needs, but shall not be held responsible in the event we are unable to do so. Moreover, Passages by Peter's Way is not responsible for the denial of services by any carriers, hotels, restaurants, or other independent suppliers.

CANCELLATIONS/REFUNDS: From the time your deposit is received up to 130 days prior to departure, there is a \$250.00 nonrefundable cancellation fee per person. From 129 to 100 days prior to departure, the cancellation fee will be \$350.00 per person. For cancellations received from 99 days prior up to the day of departure the cancellation fee will be 100% of package price per person including taxes, single supplement, deviations fees and any other costs incurred (if applicable). (Travel insurance is offered as protection in case of illness, please see TRAVEL INSURANCE). **Tour participation is nontransferable. Names cannot be transferred on reservations or airline tickets.** Refund requests (if applicable) can only be honored when submitted in writing to Passages by Peter's Way. All refund requests are subject to cancellation restrictions as set forth above. No refund will be made for any accommodations or services included in the tour that you do not use.

TRAVEL DOCUMENTS: All participants must have a valid passport. U.S. Passports must be valid for at least six (6) months, subsequent to return date. Special entry requirements for non-U.S. citizens may apply. Please consult the appropriate Consulate for current requirements. It is solely the passenger's responsibility to ensure that all documents needed are completed and current. Passages by Peter's Way will not be held responsible for lack of current and valid entry documents.

SERVICE CHARGES: All service charges and local taxes as imposed by hotels are included in the program rate. Although service charges are included, it is customary to leave \$1.00 per person for the waiters after each meal; \$1.00 per person per day for the maid/bell boys.

TIPPING: For good work, recommended (but voluntary) tipping to your driver is \$3.00 per passenger per day; to the tour manager/guide, \$5.00 per passenger per day. Tips for the bus driver and tour manager/guide are normally given as a group at the end of the tour. Other gratuities are usually handled individually.

TRAVELER HEALTH ADVISORY: All passengers must ensure that they are medically and physically fit for travel and that such traveling will not endanger themselves or others as pilgrimages entail a lot of walking, climbing up/down stairs, etc. Any passenger who is physically challenged must submit a certificate from his/her medical doctor stating that he/she is capable of taking part in this pilgrimage without assistance. If special assistance is required, the passenger must travel with a companion willing and capable of providing any necessary assistance.

TRAVEL INSURANCE: It is strongly recommended that all participants buy insurance when they travel since the tour operator is not responsible for lost or damaged luggage or trip interruption. Passages by Peter's Way offers an optional Passenger Travel Protection Plan. These benefits and services help insure the well being of the passenger while traveling worldwide. The plan payments are based on total package price, including departure taxes, fuel surcharges, single supplements, deviation fees, late charges, etc. The plan payment for total package prices from \$3,001.00 and over is \$199.00. **If the plan payment is made at the time of deposit or within 10 days of receiving the Passages by Peter's Way "Tour Deposit Acknowledgment Letter," the passenger will be covered for pre-existing conditions. However, the insurance plan can be purchased at anytime thereafter, excluding Coverage for pre-existing conditions, until final payment has been made. Plan payments will not be accepted after final payment has been made. All plan payments are non-refundable.** If you choose to extend your stay or embark on a pre-tour program, travel insurance protection can be purchased for an additional \$4.00 per day, limited to thirty (30) days total. Additional coverage needs to be requested, the insurance plan will not automatically be extended. The extended insurance plan will only cover pre-paid arrangements made through by Passages by Peter's Way Tours. **The Passenger Travel Protection Plan includes coverage for the following:** trip cancellation/interruption, baggage/personal effects, emergency evacuation, repatriation, accident/sickness medical expenses, accidental death dismemberment & 24-hour Emergency Assistance Services provided by On Call International. **PLEASE NOTE:** For complete details of coverage, terms, Conditions, exclusions, and pre-existing conditions for the insurance protection provided, refer to the Description of Coverage, which you will receive with your travel documents.
