A posada is a Mexican Christmas tradition the nights before Christmas. A group of people led by a man and woman representing Mary and Joseph go from one home to another seeking shelter. They sing for help and from inside the people sing for them to go away. After being turned away three times they finally go to home (or hall) that takes them in. At that point there are some prayers and food including tamales and punch and then a fiesta including a pinata. The Posada is an experiential celebration recalling the journey of Mary and Joseph. It reminds us that we are pilgrims in this world and that we should be aware of the less fortunate.
