CIRCLE OF GRACE

Out of concern for all God's people and in response to the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops' *Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People*, we have a program for the safe environment education of children and young people supported and mandated by Most Rev. Robert W. Finn, Bishop, Diocese of Kansas City-St. Joseph.

This program is called ***Circle of Grace***. Circle of Grace aims to equip our children and young people by arming them with essential knowledge and skills grounded in the richness of our faith. This program helps children and young people to understand their own (and other's) dignity in mind, body, and spirit.

Circle of Grace training will be taught in grades pre-school thru 8th grade. Parents will be advised of the training before it begins and again once complete.

St Bridget Parish School of Religion Program Rules and Helpful Hints

- Children must be 4 years of age by July 31st in order to attend the preschool class.
- The circle drive at our entrance is only wide enough for one vehicle. This may be used for dropping off students, but please do not park. This is not fair for other parents trying to drop off students and it creates an unsafe area for your children.
- We will be using both the upstairs and downstairs entrances. Once the class sizes are known the rooms will be assigned and you'll know which entrance works best for you.
- Class starts promptly at 6:30 p.m. and students need to be here as soon as possible.
- As in the past, all children will be escorted by their teachers to the church at 7:30. We will have a short prayer service. Parents are invited and encouraged to attend. Children will be dismissed at 7:45 to their parents at the church. For your child's safety, parents are requested to come in and get your children. The parking lot is a dangerous place and our first priority is your children.
- There is no food allowed in the education building. Please, if you send treats for a special occasion, make sure it is wrapped and will be passed out at the time of dismissal. (When we have a SOR party we will be moving the party to the church basement.)
- If Pleasant Hill Schools are let out early or cancelled completely due to inclement weather St. Bridget's School of Religion is also cancelled for that evening. You may also watch channel 9 news for the listing that runs along the bottom of your screen.
