TERMS OF THE WEEK

JESUS — his human name Yeshua, "The Lord saves"

LORD — someone who cares for you and rules your life

GOD THE SON — God in human form, Jesus

CRUCIFIXION — Jesus' death on a cross, a cruel and humiliating way to execute a criminal

CHRIST — Greek title meaning "the anointed," i.e. a king or ruler

SAVIOR — someone who rescues you when you are lost, especially lost in sin

RESURRECTION — Jesus' restoration to life on Easter Sunday, his defeat over death

MESSIAH — Hebrew word meaning "anointed," i.e. same as "Christ"

TRINITY — The Tri-unity of God: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit - Creator, Redeemer, Sanctifier
