1. Have you ever seen, heard of, or been in a flood? Share your experience with the group.
2. Read **Genesis 6:1-9**. Why did God decide to destroy humankind? What are some of the evil things human beings did at 4r God created them? (Think about the topics from the past two weeks.) Why didn't God destroy Noah?
3. Read **Genesis 6:9-22**. This is the story of Noah. What were Noah's sons' names? What was Noah's wife's name? Whom did the Lord instruct Noah to bring with him on the ark?
4. What are the dimensions of the ark and how many levels does it have?
5. Write **Genesis 6:22** in the space below. Was Noah obedient? NO YES (circle one)
6. Let's take a vote. If you were friends with Noah (and didn't know the outcome of this story), would you get on board with Noah and help him build the ark? OR would you ignore Noah because you think he's crazy? Why?

7. Read **Genesis 7:17-24**. Can you imagine the entire earth being flooded? The Lord destroyed everything that breathed. What do you think about what God did?
8. Ask your WWYG Guide to read **Genesis 8**. Number the following events in proper order.
- \_\_\_\_\_ God told Noah and his family to leave the boat.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Noah sent out a raven to see if the water had dried up.
- \_\_\_\_\_ God remembered Noah and his family where were stranded in the ark.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Noah built an altar to offer sacrifices to the Lord.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Noah sent the dove to find dry land, and the dove flew back to the ark.
- \_\_\_\_\_ God promised never again to destroy everything that breathes.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Noah sent the dove, and the dove brought Noah an olive tree leaf.
- \_\_\_\_\_ God stopped the water from coming from the earth and from the sky.
9. Read **Genesis 9:8-17**. For whom did God create the rainbow?
10. Read **Genesis 9:18-29**. What do you think about the end of this story? Is Noah still obedient to God? Why or why not?
