2. Read **1 Kings 1:1-2:12**. What did Adonijah do that went against God's will?

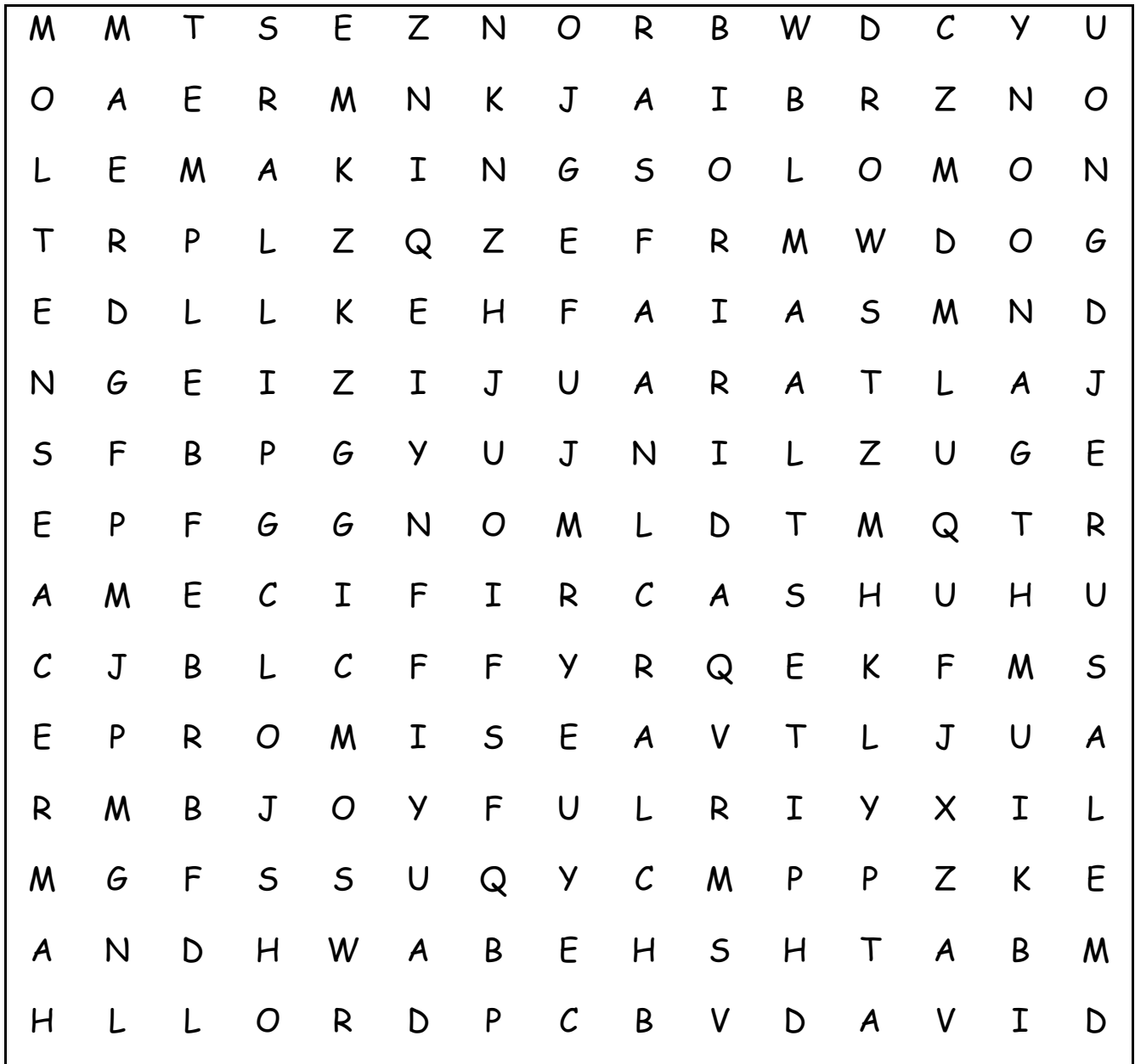
3. Look over **1 Kings 1-11** and think about what we talked about in large group. What were some of Solomon's contributions to the Israel nation?
