

WELCA COLLECTIONS FOR LUTHERAN WORLD RELIEF AND GLOBAL MISSIONS

Since last June the Women of our church have collected and sent 102 different kits to Lutheran World Relief Missions and Global Missions. The need is great and we would like to invite the whole church to join us in collecting for mission kits.

LWR collects items for different kits (sewing, layettes, school and health). Look for the box marked "LWR Missions", which will be placed at the entrance of the Fellowship Hall to place your items in.

If it would be easier for you to make a money donation, make a check out to "Crosslake Lutheran WELCA" and write LWR on the memo and place it in the offering. For the next few months we will be collecting items for:

SEWING KITS

Cotton or cotton-blend fabric (no knits or polyester); fabric should have no stains or holes and be cut into a piece measuring:

2 ¼ yards of 60 inches wide fabric, or

3 yards of 44 inch wide fabric, or

4 yards of 36-inch wide fabric

One package of about 10-15 needles for hand sewing (needles purchased in larger packages can be divided by inserting 12 needles into a swatch of felt or thick fabric)

One spool of matching general purpose thread, 250-300 yards

Six to 10 average –size matching buttons (1/2 inch to ¾ inch preferred); attach bottoms to a card or string together with yarn or heavy cord.
